record with a save. Worked a 4.62 ERA through 48.2 innings of work. Punched 40 K's on 22 walks.

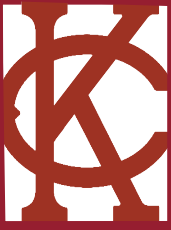
